Call for Nominations.

Code Enforcement Officer Of The Year. This award is given to an officer in good standing with the Illinois Association of Code Enforcement who is not a current Board Member. The award recipient shall be currently engaged in the Code Enforcement Profession and has gone above and beyond the call of duty in addition to their normal day to day job requirements. They should consistently serve as a good example for their jurisdiction and peers as well as practicing solid ethics and continually shows professionalism.

Code Enforcement Agency of the Year. Presented to a Department or Division with members in good standing with the Illinois Association of Code Enforcement, that has demonstrated that they have accomplished one of the following criteria;

1. Created new innovative or unique ways that code enforcement can be enforced.
2. Has positively and successfully implemented a marketing campaign to their community promoting Code Enforcement or;
3. Created printed materials used in the education of the public regarding code compliance, code enforcement programs or policies and procedures.

Please explain how your department or division accomplished the above. Explain the process, problems and outcome of the program that made a difference for your department or division. You may submit supporting documents with your application.

President's Award. Presented by the President of IACE to any member in good standing that the President feels that has shown outstanding professionalism, character and dedication to the profession, peers and the organization.
